Have you or household member tested negative after initial diagnosis?

Are you awaiting results from a COVID-19 test?

Do you have a fever?

Do you have a runny nose?

Do you have a sore throat?

Do you have a dry cough?

Do you have shortness of breath?

Do you have sneezing, sinus pressure or pain unrelated to seasonal allergies?

Have you experienced unexplained headaches, fatigue, or weakness?

Have you lost your sense of taste or smell?
